




Retirement Savings Contributions Credit (Saver's Credit) You may be able to take a tax credit for making eligible contributions to your IRA or employer-sponsored retirement plan • 50%, 20% or 10% of your retirement plan or IRA contributions up to \$2,000 (or \$4,000 if married filing jointly) • Based on your income and filing status Eligibility (must meet all three) • Age 18 or older • Not a full-time student • Not claimed as a dependent on another person's return
